Turn your old cell phone into a Hopeline

Nearly one in four women, one in seven men and more than 3 million children in the United States are affected by domestic violence.

You can donate a cell phone by following these four easy steps:

- STEP 1:** Erase any data from the phone and disconnect the phone's service with your wireless provider.
- STEP 2:** Remove any storage cards and SIM cards from the phone.
- STEP 3:** Power off the phone.
- STEP 4:** Place your wireless phone from any service provider along with the battery, charger and any accessories you wish to donate in a plastic bag.
